What to Bring to Camp:

- Pillow, twin sheets and blanket or sleeping bag
- Toiletries
- Bath towel, wash cloth, soap, shampoo
- Insect repellent (optional)
- Sunscreen!!!
- A pen
- Clothes/shoes that can get dirty
- Note that tennis shoes are needed for most activities – not flip flops
- Modest swimsuit, tankinis okay (no bikinis) and pool towel
- Light jacket
- Flashlight (optional)
- Money for camp store (optional)
- Snacks to share and for yourself (optional)

- Water bottle with your name on it (Please do not bring soda)
- **Medicine must be clearly marked with camper's name and given to the Camp Nurse**
- Good attitude
- **PREPARE FOR RAIN!!!!**

DON'T Bring to Camp:

- Radios
- Computer Games
- Tobacco of any kind
- Fireworks
- Valuables
- Weapons of any kind
- Bad Attitude

DRESS CODE

- Modest clothing: shirts, jeans, modest shorts and tennis shoes are great!

Camp Rules:

- Anyone who chooses to disobey rules regarding safety, will be sent home.
- Follow all Cave Springs rules.
- **Be *where* you are supposed to be, when you are supposed to be there, doing *what* you are supposed to be doing, the way you are supposed to be doing it.**
- Respect one another and each other's personal items.
- No girls in boys' cabins.
- No boys in girls' cabins.
- Shoes should be worn at all times.
- Campers are not allowed to leave the cabin during lights-out hours.
- Wear shirts, a cover-up or a towel around you, to and from the springs.
- Turn in all medicine to the Nurse upon arrival. All medication should be clearly labeled with camper's name.
- ***Cell phones are not needed or recommended, however if the camper's parent would like their child to keep one, it must remain in the camper's room and only used to communicate with parents during free time.*** Counselors are not responsible for cell phones! Failure to abide by cell phone rules will result in cell phone confiscation.
- Campers arriving in personal vehicles should not leave the campgrounds without notifying the director first.
- Hands off the musical equipment or any other equipment in the chapel area
- Cabins and other Cave Springs equipment are not our personal property and should be treated with respect.
